#### **Selective High School Applications for Year 7 2019**

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 15 March 2018.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2019, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address). Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from 10 October 2017 in a printed application information booklet and at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunityclasses/">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunityclasses/</a> year-7.

The application website opens at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-andopportunity-">https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-andopportunity-</a> classes/year-7 on 10 October 2017 and closes on 13 November 2017. You must apply before the closing date. There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 10 October 2017.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

# PBL - Positive Behaviour for Learning Term 4 Update

At Panania North we have high expectations of our students' learning and behaviour. During the last two terms we have focussed on the personal qualities exhibited by effective learners. You may

have heard your child/ children discuss 'grit', 'collaboration', 'curiosity' for example. These qualities alert students to the skills and responsibility they each have toward the success of their own learning.



Similarly, students have a responsibility to meet the expectations of behaviour in order to maximise learning time. As the end of the year draws closer and students experience the mix of emotions this brings, it is important that we continue to maintain our high expectations in both learning and behaviour.

All students commence each day with a fresh start on 'Ready to Learn'. A verbal reminder is given to students who do not engage in learning or disturb the progression of the lesson by interrupting or distracting others. If this behaviour continues the students are asked to 'think about' their behaviour choices and reengage in learning. Further disruption will result in students going to 'time-out' in another classroom for 3-5 minutes. If this happens, you will be notified by letter and/or a phone call that a time-out has occurred.


Through our Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) lessons, students are made aware of the school expectations of 'Be Safe, Be Respectful and Be a Learner'. Teachers make every effort to create positive classroom environments that support learning and appropriate behaviour. If your child receives a 'time-out' note, please discuss the rights that all students of Panania North have to uninterrupted and disruption-free learning time.
