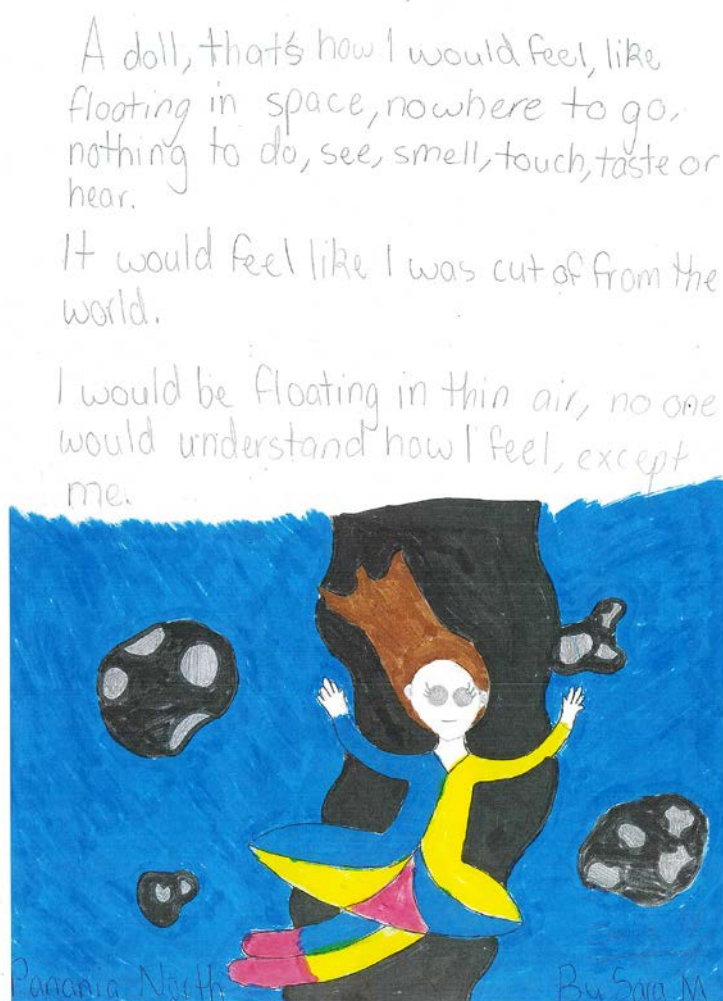
ENROLMENTS ARE SOON CLOSING FOR ETHICS CLASSES

Panania North Public School, working in conjunction with Primary Ethics is introducing ethics classes this year as an option for children who do not attend Special Religious Education (SRE) / Scripture. Primary Ethics has been authorised by the NSW government to create curriculum and deliver these classes, which will be provided at our school by volunteer teachers who receive full training by Primary Ethics.

Classes are inquiry-based and children use dialogue and discussion to learn how to think about ethical matters through the give-and-take of reasoned argument. They provide an opportunity for children to develop skills in collaborative inquiry, logical reasoning, critical thinking, respectful disagreement, listening and self-expression. Topics the children in different age groups may cover include: Empathy, Being similar and being different, Fairness, Good reasons, Understanding the rules, Disagreeing respectfully, Moral responsibility, and Are some things just wrong.

If you would like your child to enrol in these classes, please return the Permission Note before the end of next week. Because we currently have limited resources, we will then advise which children have been successful.

Classes are provided free of charge.
