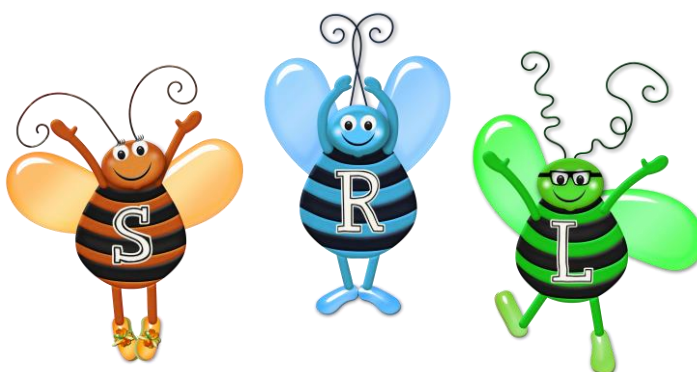

PANANIA NORTH CHICKENS & GARDEN

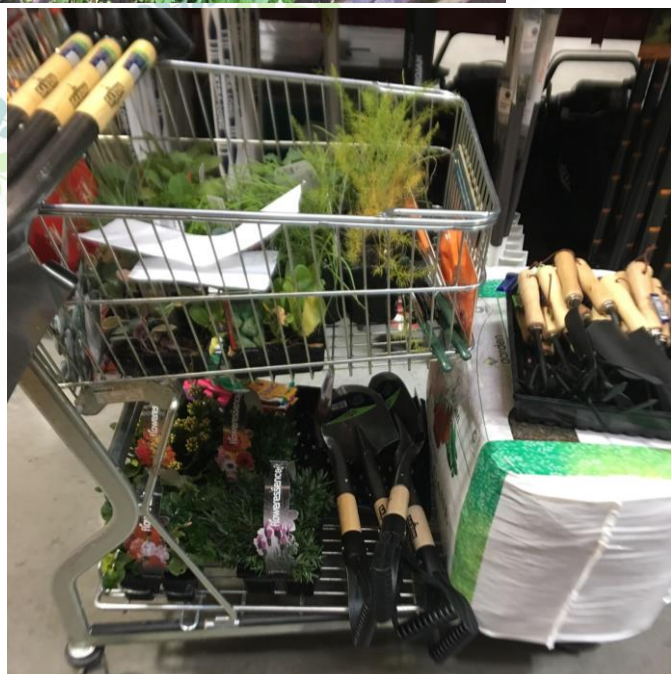
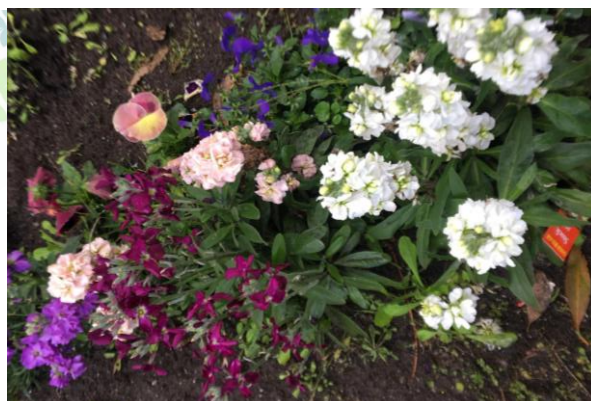

Behind the cricket nets, we have fenced off an area and built a coop, which will provide our friends with a safe place to sleep, sun bake, eat and roam away from the dangers of flying soccer balls and local predators. We hope they settle in quickly and are happy in their new home. Each Stage will be running a competition to name a chicken. Feel free to pop up and check them out in their space, but please be respectful of them and their space.

Our community garden is thriving! With the dedication of Mr Slyney and his gardening crew constantly tending to our garden, we are seeing lots of leafy greens, beans, eggplants and flowers popping up. As you are all probably aware, our very creative children at PNPS have initiated, created and developed their own building and construction area. This area exists in the busy bee nature area and the grass area near the flagpoles.

Creative play and these kinds of activities can help young children develop their senses through exploration and discovery. They let students express how they see the world and their place in it. Through building and creating, they can also use **creative play** to communicate their feelings.

All children involved are extremely engaged and it would be devastating if we have to end it due to arguments, injuries or negative behaviours brought back into the classroom. 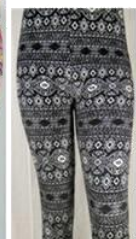
