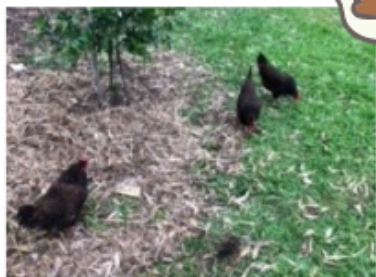

We are asking for pre-loved toys, games, puzzles, books and Lego. Also jewellery, clothes, out-grown stuffed animals and craft items.

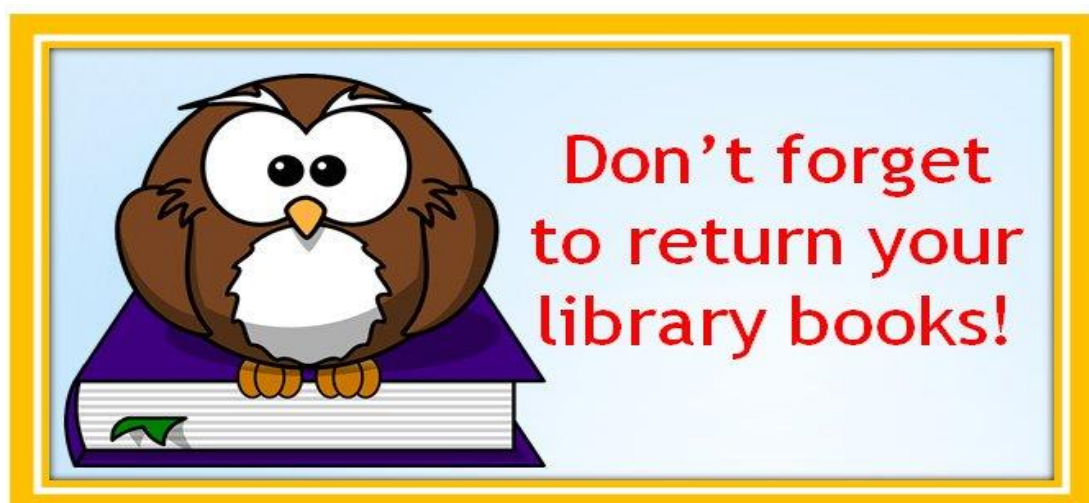
What a great opportunity to have a mini spring clean, making room for new Christmas presents to arrive.

Please ensure that all items are clean, intact and have all their pieces before donating. All donations can be delivered to the Stage 3 block near the top playground.

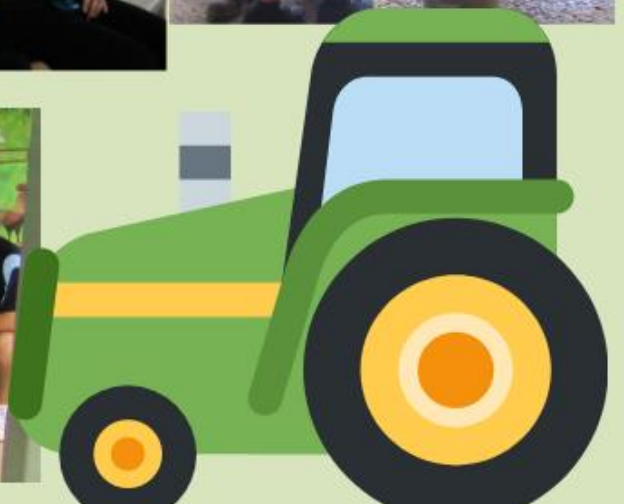

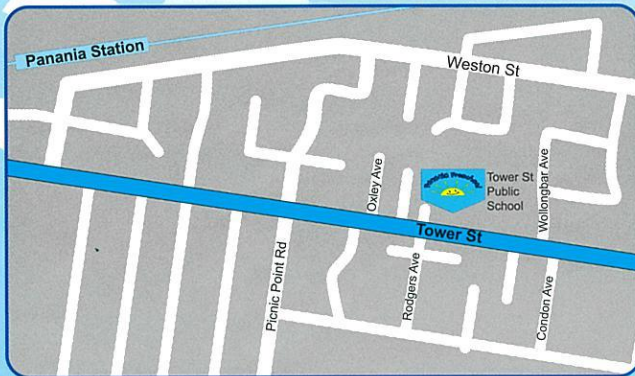
