Buying Uniforms

We're open every Friday from 8.30am to 9.15am, or until everyone waiting is served.

Order Forms – You can pick up uniform order forms from the school office, the Uniform Shop or you can print from the link on the notes page on the school's web site. Complete an order form anytime - Simply send your payment & form with your child (please separate from school payments). We'll make the order up on Friday & deliver it to your child's class.

Payment options – The Uniform Shop accepts credit/debit cards, cash and cheques. If you do not have the correct money with you, the shop is unable to extend credit. Cheques should be made payable to Panania North Public School Uniform Shop. Please note that there is a fee of \$20 for dishonoured cheques.

Exchange and refund – If you purchase an item and find it unsuitable, please return it as soon as possible with the tags still attached, and your receipt. If we cannot exchange your item for something more suitable, we are happy to issue you a cash refund (will take 7 days to process), credit card refund or credit note.

Second Hand Items – From \$2

Did you know we stock a large range of donated second-hand uniform items in good condition? We have shorts, shirts, sports uniforms & sometimes dresses & jackets. Most items are \$2 unless otherwise marked.

We also appreciate the donation of second-hand uniforms, either directly to the shop or through the school office. If you are kind enough to bring in pre-loved items, it would be helpful to us if the clothing is washed and clean, without holes or tears.

Label It!

Huge amounts of items end up as lost property each term. Many don't make it back to their owner, as they're not labelled, so make sure you clearly label all items - especially hats, jumpers and lunch items!
