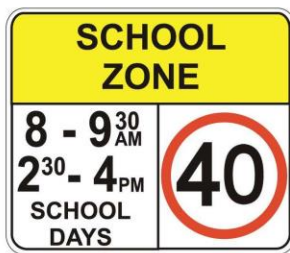

# Road Safety



40km/h school zones slow traffic on the roads around schools.

This is to help protect children on their way to and from school

**Fines for speeding in a School Zone vary depending on speed, the maximum penalty is \$2530**

**+ 7 Demerit Points (School Zone)**



**No Stopping** - You cannot stop in this area **for any reason**. This sign exists to keep sight lines clear for drivers and children so both have more time to avoid crashes.

**Penalty \$330 + 2 Demerit Points (School Zone)**



**No Parking** - You can only stop in this zone for a maximum of two minutes, to drop off and pick up passengers. You must **not** leave your vehicle unattended.

This sign exists to provide a safe place for older children to be set down and picked up without endangering other children.

**Penalty \$183 + 2 Demerit points (School Zone)**



**Bus Zone** - You must **not** stop or park in a bus zone unless you are driving a bus.

This sign exists to provide a safe place for large buses to set down and pick up school children.

**Penalty \$330 + 2 Demerit Points (School Zone)**
