The Currawongs have had a great start to the year, engaging in their learning in a variety of ways. We are also beginning to understand and take ownership of our learning through the use of flexible seating, ensuring that we are working with people who we work best with.


This term we took the opportunity to further our understanding about ANZAC Day and the meaning behind the celebration. We read books, imagined what it would have felt like as a soldier, and cooked ANZAC biscuits.

During English we have had a big focus on the use of descriptive words to enhance our writing. We were able to use our knowledge as we came together as a class to create a 'word bank' used when creating our Mother's Day cards. It was wonderful to see students engaging and asking for cards to be generated in a variety of languages.

Last term we were fortunate to be involved in the Life Skills Yoga program where we learnt about mindfulness, respect, breathing exercises, how to build resilience and developing self-regulation. This term we attended the Life Education Session – Mind Your Medicine. Students were able to draw on their knowledge from the Yoga program as they discussed factors that influence someone's sense of self-worth, as well as things that affect our health and well-being including drugs and medicine. We will continue to learn about and investigate the program further in class, which everyone is excited about.
